

One of the main purposes of our club is to support the fun hobby of metal detecting and so we are happy to do that, especially by helping out those new to the hobby.



#### **RETURN OF THE MARBLE GAME FUNDRAISER!**

Here is how it works: There will be a bag, that will have eleven white marbles and one red marble. Anyone can purchase tickets at \$1.00 each (with a maximum of Five tickets) per meeting.

All ticket will be placed in a container. One ticket will be drawn and the holder of that ticket will have the chance to draw a marble from the bag. If that person draws the red marble then they receive 1/2 of the money that was taken in on the purchase of all the tickets sold. The other 1/2 of money goes to the club.

If the person draws a white marble then they do not win anything and next month there will be another drawing with only ten white marbles and one red marble. Every month with no winner means a better chance to draw the red marble next month.

All the money stays in the pot until the red marble is drawn.

When there is a winner, that person splits the pot and then next month it starts over again with eleven white marbles and one red marble. Have fun and good luck!
