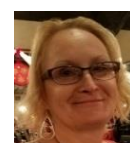

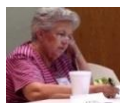

**Most Pull Tabs:** 1) Mitch 14, 2) Juan 11, 3) Earl with 10.

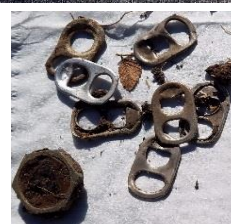
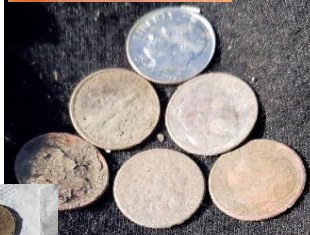
