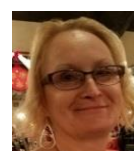

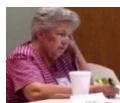

MARBLE GAME FUNDRAISER WINNER (July):

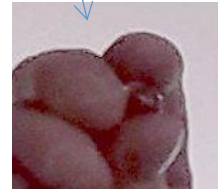
